RESOLUTION NO. 2019-1

A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE HUNTINGTON COUNTY FLOOD RESPONSE & EVACUATION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the County of Huntington established a Flood Response Committee ("Committee") in 2015 to prepare the County for future flood-related disasters and mitigate risk to life and property, and the Committee determined that a flood response plan would serve towards meeting those needs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Huntington County, Indiana, contracted with Butler, Fairman & Seufert, Inc. to assist the Committee in preparing a Flood Response & Evacuation Plan ("FREP") for all jurisdictions in Huntington County. The resulting FREP is attached and is incorporated hereto as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Markle, Indiana, find after investigation and deliberation that the adoption of the FREP is necessary and prudent for the flood hazard safety of Town citizens;

WHEREAS, this is a multi-jurisdictional plan and cities and towns that participated in the planning process may choose to also adopt the FREP;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Markle, Indiana, that the Town of Markle supports the flood response and evacuation planning efforts and wishes to adopt the Huntington County Flood Response & Evacuation Plan, effective immediately.
